

Indian Naval Sailing Vessel Tarini on her Third Leg of Circumnavigation

1. Indian Naval Sailing Vessel (INSV) Tarini, manned by an all women Indian Crew, left Lyttelton, New Zealand on 12 December 2017 on her third leg of circumnavigation and is expected to reach Port Stanley, Falklands by end of the month.
2. The first leg of the voyage from Goa to Fremantle, Australia was covered in 42 days and the second from Fremantle to Lyttelton, New Zealand in 23 days. The third leg from Lyttelton to Port Stanley spans over 3000 miles and is considered as the longest and toughest part of the voyage. We expect the vessel to touch our shores (Cape Town) in early March 2018.
